

GRAN TOUR D'ITALIA

The ideal solution for those who visit Italy for the first time or for those who want to enjoy as much as possible of this beautiful country. A dense tour of art, history and culture.

1st Day

Arrival in Venice. Transfer to hotel and check-in. Panoramic tour of the city. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

2nd Day

After breakfast, transfer to Piazza San Marco. Guided tour (half day) of the city: Piazza San Marco, the Doge's Palace, the Bridge of Sighs, the Campanile, the Clock Tower. After lunch departure for Rome. Arrival in the evening, transfer to hotel. Dinner and overnight.

Optional: a day dedicated to the visit of Padua, a beautiful city with one of the oldest universities in Italy. Padua attracts thousands of pilgrims, who come every year from all over the world to admire the Basilica of St. Anthony.

3th Day

Full day city tour. After breakfast, guided tour (half day) of the Ancient Rome: the Roman Forum, the Arch of Constantine, the Circus Maximus, the Pantheon, the Colosseum. Afternoon at leisure. Dinner and overnight.

4th Day

After breakfast guided tour (half day) of the Catholic Rome: Vatican Museums, the Sistine Chapel, the Basilica of St. Peter. In the afternoon departure to Naples. Arrival in the evening, dinner and overnight.

5th Day

After breakfast departure to Mount Vesuvius and Pompeii. Visit of the most famous volcano in the world and of the excavations. The tour continue to Sorrento, a picturesque town built on a cliff overlooking the Gulf of Naples. Transfer by boat to the Isle of Capri. Visit of the Gardens of Augustus and Villa San Michele. Boat ride to the famous Blue Cave. Return to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

Optional: a day dedicated to the visit of Napoli

6th Day

After breakfast departure to Florence, with a stop in Pisa. Visit of the Leaning Tower and the Square of Miracles. Lunch and free time. In the late afternoon transfer to the nearby Montecatini. Dinner and overnight.

7th Day

After breakfast guided tour (half day) of Florence: Piazza della Signoria, Ponte Vecchio, the Uffizi Gallery, Giotto's Bell Tower. Free afternoon for shopping or private visits. In the evening return to the hotel in Montecatini. Dinner and overnight.

Optional: a day dedicated to the visit of Montepulciano and Montalcino, famous for the homonym wines.

8th Day

After breakfast departure to Milan, the financial center of Italy and the world capital of fashion. Guided tour (half day) of the city: the Castello Sforzesco, the Gothic Cathedral and the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, the masterpiece of Leonardo Da Vinci's "L'Ultima Cena". Free afternoon for shopping. Dinner and overnight.

Optional: a whole day for shopping, accompanied by a personal shopper.

9th Day

Departure after breakfast
