

# ITALY OF WINE

An original tour to discover the magnificent and varied Italian wine heritage. From the land of Nebbiolo to the territory of Prosecco, crossing the Cinque Terre, Emilia Romagna and Valpolicella.

## 1<sup>st</sup> Day

Arrival in Turin. Transfer to Asti and check-in. Then we move in Canelli, wine center and home to many wine producers. The tour continues in the restored underground cellars Contratto. Lunch at a local agriturismo. In the afternoon visit to the Museum Bersano of Nizza Monferrato, dedicated to the peasant-enoic civilization. Then we set off for a tour of the Alfiano's Castle of Razzano. Guided tour of the winery and wine tasting. Dinner and overnight.

Optional: A day in Turin (visit to the Egyptian Museum or the National Museum of Cinema and tour of the city)

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Day

After breakfast departure to Frassinello Monferrato and visit of the Castle of Lignano. Tour of the winery and the wonderful park. Then we move to Morsasco. Visit of the wineries with tasting of traditional production. Possibility to learn the techniques of vinification and bottling of wines. Lunch with typical products. Guided tour of the ancient cellar of the Monferrato Castle. Towards evening departure to La Spezia. Dinner and overnight.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Day

After breakfast, departure to Riomaggiore. Guided tour and tasting at the winery Bargòn to discover the famous sweet wine Sclacchetrà. Then guided visit to the Cantina Cinque Terre. There the stages of processing and cultivation will be explained and you can visit the vineyards. Move to Monterosso for lunch. Stop at the Cantina du Sclacchetrà Cinque Terre in Monterosso to taste the typical products of the area. Departure to Modena. Check-in, dinner and overnight.

Optional: one or more days to visit the Cinque Terre

## 4<sup>th</sup> Day

After breakfast departure to Sorbara. Guided tour with Lambrusco wine tasting at the Winery Divinja. The tour continues to Montecchio for the guided tour to Acetaia Medici and the wine museum. Tasting of typical products. Lunch at the agriturismo. Visit to Casale del Groppone to taste the typical products of the territory. Possibility to visit the cheese factory, the ham factory, the cellar and the vineyards. Then we move to Verona. Check-in at the hotel, dinner and overnight.

Optional: tour of the city of Modena and visit the Ducale Palace

### **5<sup>th</sup> Day**

First stop the fourteenth-century Villa Alighieri Serego with wine and local products tasting, including the famous Amarone of Valpolicella.

The tour continues with a visit to the Cantina Michele Castellani. Visit the cozy rooms of aging to learn the art of making wine. The tour ends with a tasting of fine wines and cheeses of Lessinia.

Lunch in a typical restaurant in the Valpolicella.

Visit to the Garden of Pojega. Guided tour and tasting of wines and olive oil.

Moving towards Treviso. Check-in at the hotel. Dinner and overnight.

Optional: guided tour of Verona and visit the Arena

### **6<sup>th</sup> Day**

After breakfast, depart to Valdobbiadene, home of Prosecco. Guided visit to the Cantina Val D'Oca to understand how this wine is made. Tasting of wines from the cellar. Then, guided tour and tasting at the Cantina Bortolomiol. Lunch in a typical restaurant.

The tour continues to the Follina Abbey, with guided tours of the winery and vineyards. Stop for wine and typical products tasting. Visit to the Great Wine School of Conegliano.

Dinner and overnight.

Optional: guided tour of Treviso and Oderzo

### **7<sup>th</sup> Day**

Breakfast and departure.

### **The package includes:**
